Mandatory Qualifications:

- Training in Early Childhood Education.
- At least one year of experience working with babies and young children demonstrating his/her abilities to work well with the young ones.

Nice to have:

- Fluent in English and ability to communicate with parents in at least one of our two Chinese dialects: Cantonese or Mandarin (a definite asset if able to communicate in both).
- Personal experience raising children from birth is an asset.
- Experience in a multi-lingual church setting an asset, experience in working with special needs children another great asset
- Strong Biblical groundings either through formal or informal training is an asset (i.e. degree or diploma from recognized seminary or Bible College or certificates from other reputable para-church organizations).

Profile:

1. A person who loves babies and young children, seeing them as God sees them and recognizing the potentials of each individual as well as the importance of reaching them and their parents for their early childhood education.
2. A person who can work well with parents, inspiring them to see their children as a trust from the Lord for them to bring up into mature disciples of Jesus Christ.
3. A person who can work well under the leadership of pastors from different cultural backgrounds and the children ministry director, and yet maintain and hone his/her creativity in reaching out to the young and the young at heart.
4. A person who keeps learning to adjust to changing conditions as young children grow up fast. This population of the church is the one most affected by yearly changes as new babies are born (in varying numbers) and young children are promoted to be under the care of other ministries in the church.
5. A person who cares for those he/she has work with and delighted to follow their spiritual as well as physical progress, keeping them in his/her prayer life.

Major Area of Ministry Responsibilities

1. Children Sunday School and nursery.
2. Special programs of the church, including Summer programs.
3. Support and care for expecting parents.
4. Pre and post natal support for parents.
5. Help to recruit and train co-workers for the various programs gear towards babies and young children.
6. Serve as a team member in our Children Ministry Committee.
