

## Church Profile

South Calgary Chinese Evangelical Free Church was formed in 1988. We have three congregations composed of Cantonese (550-600), English (200-220) and Mandarin (80-100); including children, the church population is about 1,000.

We are an evangelical church which is part of the Evangelical Free Church of Canada and we adhere to the congregational spirit of the Free Church Movement, governed by members of the church. The church is centrally located in Calgary within 30 minutes of driving from any corner of the city.

Calgary is located east of the Canadian Rockies in the province of Alberta. The municipal population exceeds 1 million with an estimated Chinese population of 80,000 to 100,000. Calgary's major economic base is oil and gas, high tech and tourism.

Our current pastoral staff is composed of 9 full time and 3 lay workers. For the full time staff, 4 ministers mainly to the Cantonese, 2 to the English, 1 to the Mandarin, 1 to children and 1 as our Parish Nurse (including Cantonese senior ministry).

At this time, we are looking for the following positions:

- **Cantonese congregational lead pastor** to fill the post vacated by our pastor who is retiring in February 2012.
- **Parish nurse (including Cantonese ministry)** to fill the post vacated by the parish nurse who is retiring in June 2012.
- **Mandarin associate pastor**, a new position.
- **Early childhood worker**, a new part time position for infants to 6 years old.

Due to the immense pastoral needs, our church pulpit committee has posted these positions at most of the North American seminary websites and the Chinese Christian Herald (號角) magazine.
